## **WINTER WONDERLAND**

**Challenge:** Your team is to create a new winter sport and then present that sport in a **PERFORMANCE** to the appraisers. Your performance must have “theatrical elements” such as song, dance, rhyme, mime, music or acting.

**Time:** You will have up to 5 minutes to use your IMAGINATION to create your new sport as well as plan your **PERFORMANCE**.

**The Scene:** Snow is everywhere. There is nothing for you to do. But wait you are a DI team. You can create anything out of straws, paper and whatever else DI has to offer. You can create a new, fun and exciting sport. Your team will use the materials below to create a sport. That sport will then be presented to the appraisers in a **PERFORMANCE** that will include at least two theatrical elements.

- **Part One** (5 minutes): Using the materials provided your team will design your sport. You may also use this time to plan your **PERFORMANCE**.
- **Part Two** (2 minutes) Present your **PERFORMANCE** that includes the features of your winter sport

**Materials:**

2 chopsticks	6 craft sticks	1 mailing label	1 paper cup
2 mailing labels	2 rubber bands	2 paper clips	4 index cards

Your team will have a piece of paper and pencil to use as you plan and present your **PERFORMANCE**.

- Scoring:** You will receive up to
- A. 25 points for the creativity of the team’s sport.
  - B. 25 points if your performance has two or more theatrical element. .
  - C. 25 points if your creativity of the team’s performance.
  - D. 25 points for how well your team works together.

Team hints:

All IC's have points for team work. All team members should be helping with the solution. One team member can be the leader, one team member can be the materials handler, one can be the time keeper, one can be the challenge reader and one can be the score 'watcher'-the person who makes sure the solution has all the scored elements. All should contribute to the solution. If someone is a quiet person, the team leader should make sure that they ask if he or she has any ideas.

Team manager:

Have the team members rotate the positions in order for them to 'appraise' who does which job the best.

For Elementary teams have them do one theatrical element. For SL teams have them do three theatrical elements. Do not 'appraise' them on talent.
